FULL-TIME COURSES

WORK-BASED LEARNING PROGRAMMES

LYIT currently enjoys a reputation as one of Ireland's leading providers of work-based learning programmes (WBL). WBL programmes are designed and delivered in conjunction with an external employer organisation and the learners are employees in the external organisation. WBL programmes address challenges and opportunities identified by the employer and the programme is delivered at a time, place and pace that suits the employer and employee. These programmes range in duration from 4 days to 4 years depending on the employer requirements. WBL programmes can be delivered for a single employer (subject to a



minimum number of learners) or to a group of employers. In some cases funding may be available.


