The Japan Exchange and Teaching (JET) Programme invites third level graduates from all disciplines to participate in international exchange and foreign language education throughout Japan.

There are 2 types of position available:

1. Assistant Language Teacher (ALT):

ALTs are usually placed in publicly run schools or local boards of education. They engage in English language instruction under the guidance of Japanese teachers of English. ALTs must be interested in the Japanese education system and working actively with students.

2. Coordinator for International Relations (CIR):

CIRs are usually placed in local government offices, and engage in international exchange activities carried out by the contracting organisation.
