Funded by Enterprise Ireland under the Applied Research Enhancement Programme and led by the CNRG research team at LYIT, the WiSAR Lab has become a centre of excellence in wireless sensor networks and the hub of research and applied wireless solutions for technology companies in the North West of Ireland.
