GUIDELINES

Sanctuary Scholarships

- Up to 3 Sanctuary Scholarships will be available annually.
- Application for Sanctuary Scholarships is open to academically eligible asylum seekers and those in Direct Provision, Priority will be given to those in Direct Provision.
- Sanctuary Scholarships are only available only to migrants who do not qualify for consideration under the 1916 Fund.
- The Sanctuary Scholarship will consist of a waiver of the fee that normally applies to non-EU students.
- In addition to the fee waiver there will also be bursary of €2k per awardee per annum, which is intended to help towards some costs of attending college. It is not intended to cover full cost of attending college.
- Applications for Sanctuary Scholarships will assessed and disbursed via LYIT's Access Office.

How to Apply

The first step is to make general application for a place in LYIT and to establish academic eligibility. The general college application process is as follows:-

Those whose education terminated at second level and anyone seeking entry to year 1 must apply via CAO, see www.cao.ie. Ideally CAO applications should be submitted before February 1st (and, in any case, no later than May 1st at 5.15pm) in the proposed year of entry.

or

 Anyone who has already successfully completed at least one year of higher education may apply for advanced entry into a related area of study. Applicants for advanced entry should apply directly to LYIT. See https://www.lyit.ie/Study-at-LYIT/How-to-Apply-for-Full-time-Undergraduate-Courses/Advanced-Entry-Add-on.
