Induction and Garda Vetting for all courses in the Department of Early Education and Social Studies will take place on Wednesday 13th September 2023. Please check the ATU Donegal website for details of the registration time for your programme. You can begin the Registration process with Online Registration before you visit the campus. During On-Campus registration you will receive your ATU Donegal Student Card and ATU Student Account login details.

You are **required** to complete **Garda Vetting** and **Mandatory Training** as part of your programme. It is very important that you engage with the Garda Vetting Liaison Officer and your Department Administrator regarding these additional requirements as your **registration may not be complete until you have submitted all relevant documentation.**

You are encouraged to complete the **Online Computer Services Induction** as soon as possible. When you have registered, please log in to your ATU Student Email and visit our Virtual Learning Environment, Blackboard. The **Student Toolkit** is on Blackboard and offers everything you need to know about Student Services at ATU Donegal. Congratulations on being offered a place of study in the Department of Early Education and Social Studies at ATU Donegal. The Department Early Education and Social Studies is a vibrant, dynamic department with approx. 500 students in the Faculty of Science and Health at ATU Donegal. It is equipped with up-to-date equipment and state-of-the-art laboratories.

As part of your programme of study you will take both theory and practical classes. Practical classes are an essential part of your programme as they put into practice much of the theory you have been taught in class. Employers expect and require graduates to have up-to-date practical skills. The Department places great emphasis on this aspect of our programmes and students are required to attend and participate in all scheduled classes/practicals and labs. This is a full-time programme with classes taking place Monday-Friday from 09.30 17.30. In addition to scheduled classes students are also required to undertake independent learning. Students on the Early Education programmes may be asked to wear an ATU branded polo-shirt/ hoodie for some engagements. These are provided by the Department and the costs are covered by the additional course costs. (Please refer to the Quick Guide Information for further details.)

Early Education students are required to be Garda Vetted and must complete mandatory training. People Moving & Handling training is provided by the Department and is scheduled for all Year 1 students in Semester 2. Garda Vetting is mandatory, and you are required to provide proof of ID and proof of address to the Garda Vetting Liaison Officer at Registration and Induction. Your registration is not complete until your vetting is confirmed.

Placement is an integral part of your programme of study. Our academic and support staff will work with you to ensure you are prepared for placement which takes place in Semester 1 of Year 2. Placement is arranged through the Practice Placement Co-ordinator, and you are not required to arrange your own placement.

Once again congratulations on securing your place in the Department of Early Education and Social Studies. Induction for **Early Childhood Care, Health & Education Students** takes place on **Wednesday 13th September** and class starts on Monday 18th September.

You will receive information about your Class Group and Timetable at Induction.
