MODULE OPTIONS

Students can then take the following module pairs:

Cybersecurity with Software Compliance

Cybersecurity with Information Security Management

Cybersecurity with Threat Management

Students may and typically do graduate with a MSc in Cybersecurity. If a student completes a dissertation that is directly relevant to Software Compliance, Information Security Management or Threat Management and they have also completed the relevant pair of specialist modules then they can graduate with an MSc in that sub-specialism.

For example:

- If a student completes the two software compliance modules and they do a software compliance related dissertation they may ask for an MSc in Cybersecurity with Software Compliance.
- If a student completes the two information security management modules and they do an information security management related dissertation they may ask for an MSc in Cybersecurity with Information Security Management.
- If a student completes the two threat management modules and they do a threat management related dissertation they may ask for an MSc in Cybersecurity with Threat Management.

If the student wishes to graduate with one of the three sub-specialisms above then they must reference this in their dissertation proposal as the dissertation proposal will then be reviewed both for general suitability and for suitability for the sub-specialism.
